LATE PRESIDENT OF THE

CONFEDERATE STATES.

At a stated term of the Circuit Court
of the United States for the District of Virginia
held at Richmond on the First Monday of May
One thousand eight hundred and sixty seven

Be it remembered that on this Thirteenth (13th) day
of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty seven
before the Honorable the Circuit Court of the United States for the District of Virginia
at the Court House in Richmond in the said District came Jefferson Davis and
acknowledged himself to owe to the United States of America the sum of One Hundred
Thousands dollars lawful money of the said United States and Ernest Smith, Horace
Greely, Cornelius Vanderbilt, Augustus Schell, Horace F. Clark, A. Welch, David L. Johnston,
William H. Macfarland, A. D. Hassall, Isaac Davenport Jr., Graham Warwick, Gustavus W.
Myers, William H. Brumfield, James Lyons, John A. Murdoch, William H. Lyne, John Minor
Botts, James Thomas Jr. Thomas R. Price, William Allen Benjamin Woods, Thomas W.
Dowell, each of whom acknowledged himself to owe to the United States of America the
sum of Five thousand dollars of like lawful money. He paid several sums to be made
to the use of the said United States, of the goods, chattels, lands and tenements of the said parties
respectively. The condition of this recognizance is such that if the said Jefferson Davis
shall in his proper person well and truly appear at the Circuit Court of the United States for the
District of Virginia to be held at Richmond in the said District on the Fourth Monday of
November next at the opening of the Court on that day and then and there appear from day to
day and stand & abide and perform whatsoever shall be then and there ordered or adjudged
in respect to him by the said Court and not depart from the said Court without the leave
of the said Court in that behalf first had and obtained then the said recognizance
to become void, otherwise to remain in full force.
